ORDER:

In the circumstances reported by the Chief Executive Officer, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, A.P., Vijayawada in the reference second read above, Government after careful examination of the proposal and as per P.S.S., hereby accord sanction of 44,477 PensionstoSingle Womenunder NTR Bharosa Pension Scheme @ Rs. 1000/- per month.

2. The following are the eligibility criteria for extension of Social Security Pension benefit to Single/Deserted Women under NTR Bharosa Pension Scheme:-

- a) The general rules of other category pensions of NTR Bharosa pensions shall be applicable to Single woman pension.
 - i) The beneficiary should be BPL.
 - ii) The beneficiary shall be local resident of the District.
- b) Beneficiary should provide Aadhaar card, Ration card.
- c) the beneficiary, single women should not be enrolled in any other Social Security Pension Scheme or should not be a pensioner in any of the public or private pension scheme.
- d) Married women who are separated / deserted shall have above 35 years of age as on date of sanction of pension and who has separated from her husband or whose husband has deserted her and the separation period shall be more than 1 year. If the woman does not have proof of separation period, then the details could be ascertained from the local enquiry and attested by the Tahsildar with witness of the local Public representative and village/ward level government functionary.
- e) Unmarried women who are having 30 years and above of age in Rural and for Urban 35 years and above of age and no support of the family. In case of beneficiaries who remarries or gets any Employment or economic stability after the sanction of Pension, the benefit shall be discontinued after ascertaining the status. This shall be done on every month by the Pensions Disbursement officers.

3. The Director, PR & RD/ Chief Executive Officer, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
